Sonya, a Sweet Louise member from Christchurch, is pictured with her two boys, Jayden and Zediah. As a single mum, they are her "rocks", and loving, cheerful ones at that.

"Watching them grow up and mature into kind people is such a gift to me. Jayden is so clever at crafting things. He is very funny, caring and inquisitive. Zediah is so adorable... he thinks everyone is his friend. He is so talkative and friendly ... the amount of conversations he'll have in the supermarket! It's so touching to see the smile he puts on people's faces." Sonya was firstly diagnosed with primary breast cancer in 2010, age 35. Jayden was five and desperately wanted a baby brother or sister. Sonya did what she could do to fight her cancer, including undergoing a double mastectomy and breast reconstruction. Zediah came along in 2014, as a "light" in Sonya's life.

A year later Sonya felt surging pain in her body. The pain persisted without an answer.

One day Sonya said, "I think it's in my bones".

She knew before the doctors did, and sure enough, a MRI scan confirmed the cancer had spread. It was diagnosed as stage four breast cancer.

Since her secondary diagnosis Sonya has joined Sweet Louise, which she counts as a "blessing". She travelled up to Auckland last year for the Sweet Louise forum. "The conference was a real gift. I met a group of beautiful women, with fighting spirits and infectious energy. I learnt information about different treatments and I cried thinking of making a will and who would look after my children."

Back home in Christchurch, Sonya is bringing her all into raising her boys. "I am teaching them to be good people, to be kind and caring in life, to not judge people for their differences and to help others as much as they can.

Both my boys are on their way to being awesome men. I am so proud of them both. My love for them is overwhelming."

FOOD TO LOVE'S



Ingredients

- 1 & 1/2 packets of wine biscuits
- 75g butter
- 1 tbsp gelatine, plus 1/4 cup water
- 2 x 45g tins mango slices in juice
- 1/2 cup icing sugar
- 1 tbsp gelatine, plus ¼ cup water
- 500g cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup icing sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla essence
- l cup cream
- fresh mango and berries

Method

- 1. Using a food processor, whiz the biscuits to fine crumbs, then add the melted butter and pulse until well mixed. Press evenly into the base of a 23cm spring form tin and chill.
- 2. Sprinkle the gelatine over the water and let swell for 5 minutes, then microwave for 30 seconds or heat over a cup of boiling water until dissolved and smooth. Whiz the mango slices, juice and icing sugar until smooth, then blend in the gelatine. Transfer to a jug.
- **3.** Sprinkle the second measure of gelatine over the water and let swell for 5 minutes, then microwave for 30 seconds or heat over a cup of boiling water until dissolved and smooth.
- **4.** In the food processor, whiz the cream cheese, icing sugar and vanilla until smooth, then add the cream and pulse until slightly thickened and well mixed. Transfer to a jug.
- 5. Pour half the cream cheese mix over the chilled base, then smooth and chill for 20 minutes. Pour over half the mango mix and chill for 20 minutes before repeating the final two layers. Chill the cheesecake for 2 hours before cutting.
- **6.** Run a sharp knife around the cake and release the tin. Transfer to a plate and decorate with mango and fresh berries.
